# 2023 Space Club Golf League

Welcome all new members and returning members. We had a Great Year in 2022 and it is time to dust/dry off the clubs and get ready for this season. We will start 2023 with Auburn Golf Course League Appreciation Week on Thursday March 30, and will have a practice round on April 6th. Our first day of league play will be April 13th.

## **Golf Course Fees & GHIN**

For 2023, the Auburn Golf Course is raising its 9-hole rate \$1 to \$28. Their 18-hole rate is rising \$2 to \$45. In our recent BEGA meeting it was affirmed that all golfers are urged to obtain an official GHIN handicap. A great way to obtain a GHIN is to join the Auburn Men's Club (sign up by Wed March/15). It makes it a LOT easier setting up 4somes. This is Gene's first year as secretary, so let's help him learn everyone's name!

#### **Membership & Dues**

#### **Field Days**

Talking about sandbaggers 😊 ... Our Vice President Larry is scheduling the Field Days. The first Field Day will be held Saturday April 29th at North Shore Golf Course. Now is the time to put this on your schedule. These are great opportunities to play some of the better local courses and are always a lot of competitive fun.

Time to talk money. This year SCGL dues will be \$65, as listed on the 2023 Sign-Up form. Yes, there is a slight dues increase, but we are dropping the Putt Jug. The Putt Jug assisted in funding many league costs, including the BBQ, but it was a pain to collect.

**League Fees are due by April 20th.** After then there will be a \$5 late fee. If payment is not made by April 27th, the member will be ineligible to play until payment has been made. Please note that a member must be in good standing (paid up) prior to winning any prize and to be eligible for payment. We will also continue with our optional hole-in-one fee of \$2. The hole-in-one fund is HUGE, over \$1000. So when I win it, I will buy everyone a drink.

## **Pace of Play**

Occasionally the league suffers a day of slow play. Slow play usually results from groups in front of us dragging their feet. But other times we are at fault. We can all speed up play by playing "ready golf". Attached below is the Rules of Ready Golf .PDF file for your review. We should make every effort to comply with these rules.

## **Playoffs & Winners**

This year we will again use the new Playoff process. The playoff for the first half (rounds 1-10) occurs among attendees at Field Day #2. The attendee with the most points starts the day at -3, which is a nice advantage toward winning the playoff. For all attending players, the next list shows their starting score:

- -3 Attendee with the most points
- -2 Attendee with the second most points
- -1 Attendee with the third most points
- 0 Attendee with the fourth most points
- +1 Attendees with fifth (or worse) most points

The same process is used for the second half playoff, on Field Day #3. Of course, the process is run for flight 1 and again for flight 2.
