\*\*\* TIE-BREAKERS - EXPLAINED\*\*\*

## [Default-TB]

Default-TB is often used, and is the standard or default tie-breaker unless otherwise specified on a particular WFunC.

**1.** Low net. **2.** Most net: Eagles, Birdies, Pars, Bogeys etc. **3.** Latest hole better gross. **4.** Dice roll.

On most weeks there is - No need to track the raw number of Putts (sparing us the tedium).

## [Within-Among-TB]

A few WFunC events require a 2-stage tie-break system. The first stage is only "Within" each scorecard, while the second stage is "Among" all the scorecard leaders: thus the moniker Within-Among-TB.

A Within-Among-TB system is desireable when the particular WFunC rates each golfer's performance Relative to the three other golfers in his tee group; instead of each golfer's performance being entirely independent of his own tee group.

For instance, in our Most-Longest-Sunk-Shots WFunC, your chance of leading your scorecard is unfairly less if the league's best putter is in your tee group. Similarly, a golfer whose tee group includes US Open Champion Bryson DeChambeau has an unfairly poor chance of winning our Long-Drive WFunC. Also, Within-Among-TB is used for our Long-Drive and KP WFunC events because it would be a major hassle to measure these shots with moveable notecards we stick into the ground and later gather.

In contrast, we do not need Within-Among-TB for WFunC events where your performance is completely independent of, and unaffected by, the other players in your tee group. One such WFunC event is Most-Holes-LessThan-Two-Putts.

Some WFunC events can reverse the sequence of tie-breaking, by needing Among-Within-TB.

For instance, Smallest-Gross-Score-Range-Per-Scorecard.
